OSHA Recognizes Gemini's Texas Plant For Safety Practices

Taylor, TX — A recognition ceremony was held recently for Gemini Incorporated's manufacturing facilities in Taylor, Texas to present employees with OSHA's Safety and Health Recognition Program (SHARP) Award.

According to Jet Tran, Gemini's Safety and Environmental Officer, the credit goes to employees and the commitment they have demonstrated toward safety for achieving the award. "We believe safety is our responsibility both in and out of the plants, and we're continually looking for ways to improve," Tran said. "We are very appreciative of the support and assistance by the people at Texas OSHA. The input and resources they have provided us with have helped Gemini develop an effective and comprehensive safety program."

At its Texas facilities, Gemini manufactures cast letters, flat cut metal letters, and Formed plastic letters.
